Whether you take the book of Jonah literally or figuratively, it is a powerful story of God's grace for ALL people, which leads to some difficult and powerful questions. I named a few during my sermon: How can justice be served in the face of such mercy? Where is the line when it comes to showing mercy? How many chances are we to give someone who has let us down before? Where is the line between empowering and enabling? What about accountability? How can we save people from themselves? Or is that even our job? How are we to feel when we just can't do it anymore? When is enough, enough?

I don't know that there are answers to these questions, but they sure make for interesting conversation!

I encourage you to read through the book of Jonah. There are only four chapters. Then consider the questions above and the two that follow.

How do you feel about giving second chances?

How have you benefited from a second chance?

Scholars tell us this word from God was to challenge the nation of Israel in their selfish attitude toward God. God's love, grace, mercy, etc., were not just for Israel. They were chosen people, that is true. But chosen to be the bearers of good news to all people, to all the nations.

I'd be interested to hear your thoughts. And, this is a good place to invite you to participate in our Wednesday evening small group. We talk about interesting stuff like this! 6:30 on Wednesday evenings at the church or you can join us online with a Zoom link that I issue during the day on Wednesday. 
"Souper Bowl" is February 11th
