Christina Hockaday did a great job of representing you at Conference. She will offer a report of her impressions and takeaways in the days to come.

This was a difficult conference, in that 75 congregations from Missouri have chosen to disaffiliate from The United Methodist Church. Most of those leaving have concerns about where they see the denomination headed regarding human sexuality issues and inclusiveness. No changes to the UMC's Book of Discipline can happen until General Conference meets in May, 2024, but congregations across the United States have chosen to leave prior to the 2024 conference. Think about the impact divorce has on families – sadness, grief, conflict, hurt feelings. The disaffiliations have led to the same kinds of feelings among pastors, laity, conference leadership, and especially, for our Bishop. He became quite emotional during the vote to approve the disaffiliations, which, in turn, gave the rest of us the opportunity to express our own sadness.

There are sure to be more changes in the months to come, but the conference ended on a very hopeful note. Nine pastors were commissioned for leadership and service within the conference. Commissioning means

that they have completed their seminary education and will spend the next two years growing their leadership abilities, working toward ordination. Three individuals were ordained as deacons; eight as elders, welcomed into full conference membership. The ordination service is always powerful, with wonderful music and preaching. I had the honor of standing with Paul Klepees, a young man who grew up in Stewartsville, as he was ordained. I have been his friend, colleague, superintendent, and now, sibling within the Order of Elder.

God continues to be at work among us, Friends. The Holy Spirit led tens of people to come forward to affirm God's calling in their lives and to enter into a time of discernment about where God is leading them. That goes for us as the Missouri Conference, too, still called to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. We will spend the next year together planting seeds, growing our faith, being reminded of what it means to be Wesleyan, and focusing on serving and loving God and our neighbor in all that we do. It is an honor to be your pastor!


