California experienced more flooding last Monday as Hurricane Hilary continued to bring rain to parts of Southern California. Sept. 10 – We promise our SERVICE. This Sunday's worship will feature special musical guests Mark Sander and his sister Debra Sander Burnett. Their music is a tribute to their parents, Lester and Doris Sander, who were long-time members of the Clair congregation.

Americana Gospel Group Will Perform at Clair Church




