As we remember Jesus' final meal together with his friends before his arrest, we will share in Holy Communion before hearing scripture from the garden in the Mount of Olives and taking our leave.

On Good Friday, we will gather at Clair UMC at 7 PM to continue the story in a tradition of "tenebrae" or "darkness," descending with Jesus into the depths of our own stories of grief, disappointment, and betrayal. *There are several reading parts as candles are extinguished. Let me know of your willingness to participate.* We will leave the sanctuary in silence and in darkness, contemplating Jesus' sacrifice for those he loved, fulfilling his mission of Matthew 1:21 – "And she will have a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."

You are invited to begin your Easter celebration with a Sunrise Service in Ebenezer UMC's parking lot at 6:30 AM. Clair will serve breakfast beginning at 9:30 AM followed by the annual Easter egg hunt at 10:15 AM. We will have our traditional Sunday morning celebration at 11 AM.

AND, I am looking forward to Holy Humor Sunday on Apr. 24! Blessings, Friends, as Lent 2022 draws near its close. It is an honor to be your pastor.
