On this Sunday before Thanksgiving, what is it you are thankful for? Make a list!

This is also known as Christ the King Sunday – the last Sunday of the Christian year. What comes to your mind when you think about a king?

How does that traditional king image apply to Jesus Christ?

Read Luke 23:33-43. Consider the difference between a traditional king's crown and the crown of thorns Jesus wore.

A kingly responsibility is to save the people, to save the nation. The Luke passage emphasizes the word "save" several times. Consider Jesus' mission to save his people from their sins (Matthew 1:21) and the work Jesus accomplished upon the cross.

How do you allow Jesus to be the king of your life?
